The Beltonian Theatre COVID-19 RESPONSE: The Beltonian Theatre has adopted safety protocols to protect our faculty and students as much as we possibly can. These protocols will be extended to apply to the outside facilities where some of our summer camps will take place, such as filming locations around downtown Belton throughout the week. Anyone entering our building or other camp facilities will have their temperature checked via no-contact thermometer and will be asked a few basic health questions. Hand sanitizer will be provided upon entry as well. When not actively participating in programming which requires the face to be uncovered, everyone over the age of 3 will be asked to wear a mask which covers their nose and mouth. Anyone who feels sick in ANY way (cough, nausea, allergies, etc.) is asked to return (or stay at) home.

GOVERNOR’S PROTOCOLS FOR DAY YOUTH CAMPS: In accordance with the recommendations of the governor’s re-opening task force, The Beltonian Theatre will observe the following:

- Any person, staff or student, who tests positive for COVID-19 should immediately notify the Owner, Zechariah Baker, and that staff member/student will not be permitted to return to the camp. If a student or staff member of our camp tests positive for COVID-19, The Beltonian Theatre will notify all families as soon as practicable. Parents may choose either to pick up their student, or to let the student remain and trust the camp to take appropriate safeguards.
- Families should be aware that there are enhanced risks of campers being in direct contact with anyone age 65 or older for 14 days after the end of the camp session.
- All staff will be trained on appropriate cleaning and disinfection, hand hygiene, and respiratory etiquette.
- All staff will be screened each day for new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19. If such signs are present, the affected staff member will be sent home and asked to consult with health care professionals for testing. Symptomatic staff will not be allowed to return to camp until the governor’s recommended protocols are fulfilled.
- Staff will mitigate environmental exposures by enhanced cleaning and disinfecting of camp participation areas and bathrooms.
- The number of participants in camper groups will be reduced to allow for spacing that will minimize contact among camp participants.
- No parents, guardians, or friends will be permitted to visit the camp during or between camp sessions, except to drop off and pick up campers. If possible, parents and guardians should remain in their vehicles at camper drop-off and pick-up.
- We are requiring all students to purchase lunch from The Beltonian Theatre menu at 50% off and no outside food or drinks allowed to reduce the chance of outside contaminants being introduced into your environment. Unlimited water bottles will be provided free of charge to students throughout the camp.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND AGREEMENT TO ENHANCED HEALTH CARE PROTOCOLS: We have received a copy of the Governor’s “Minimum Standard Health Protocols Checklist for Day Youth Camp Families.” We have read it and the enhanced health care protocols above, and agree to abide by them, including leaving the camp or event if asked to do so.

LIABILITY RELEASE: We understand that these events have inherent dangers, both health dangers and others, that cannot be fully eliminated. We do not know the full extent of the possible ramifications of group activities at this time in relation to the continued presence of COVID-19 in our community. I hereby release The Beltonian Theatre, its directors, officers, employees, event staff, and volunteers from any liability whatsoever resulting from any injury, illness, or harm that may occur to my child while participating in or traveling to or from any other activity. As a parent, I take full responsibility for my child’s activities.

AUTHORIZATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE: I grant the Beltonian Theatre staff and directors the authority to obtain and consent to emergency medical care for my child if they deem it necessary. I retain full responsibility for the payment for any such emergency care.

MEDIA RELEASE: I give my permission for my child’s name and/or photo to be used in relation to this summer camp or event in media such as The Beltonian Theatre website, The Beltonian Theatre social media pages, newspaper/radio/television/magazine stories, etc.
