The Beltonian Theatre COVID-19 RESPONSE: The Beltonian Theatre has adopted safety protocols to protect our faculty and students as much as we possibly can. These protocols will be extended to apply to the outside facilities where some of our summer camps will take place, such as filming locations around downtown Belton throughout the week. Anyone who feels sick in ANY way (cough, nausea, allergies, etc.) is asked to return (or stay at) home. Please feel free to wear a mask or not but we will not require them.

- PROTOCOLS FOR DAY YOUTH CAMPS:** The Beltonian Theatre will observe the following:
- Any person, staff, or student, who tests positive for COVID-19 should immediately notify the Owner, Zechariah Baker, and that staff member/student will not be permitted to return to the camp. If a student or staff member of our camp tests positive for COVID-19, The Beltonian Theatre will notify all families as soon as practicable. Parents may choose either to pick up their student, or to let the student remain and trust the camp to take appropriate safeguards.
 - All staff will be screened each day for new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19. If such signs are present, the affected staff member will be sent home and asked to consult with health care professionals for testing. Symptomatic staff will not be allowed to return to camp until the governor's recommended protocols are fulfilled.
 - Staff will mitigate environmental exposures by enhanced cleaning and disinfecting of camp participation areas and bathrooms.
 - No parents, guardians, or friends will be permitted to visit the camp during or between camp sessions, except to drop off and pick up campers. If possible, parents and guardians should remain in their vehicles at camper drop-off and pick-up.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND AGREEMENT TO ENHANCED HEALTH CARE PROTOCOLS: We have received a copy of the Governor's "Minimum Standard Health Protocols Checklist for Day Youth Camp Families." We have read it and the enhanced health care protocols above, and agree to abide by them, including leaving the camp or event if asked to do so.

LIABILITY RELEASE: We understand that these events have inherent dangers, both health dangers and others, that cannot be fully eliminated. We do not know the full extent of the possible ramifications of group activities at this time in relation to the continued presence of COVID-19 in our community. I hereby release The Beltonian Theatre, its directors, officers, employees, event staff, and volunteers from any liability whatsoever resulting from any injury, illness, or harm that may occur to my child while participating in or traveling to or from any other activity. As a parent, I take full responsibility for my child's activities.

AUTHORIZATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE: I grant the Beltonian Theatre staff and directors the authority to obtain and consent to emergency medical care for my child if they deem it necessary. I retain full responsibility for the payment for any such emergency care.

MEDIA RELEASE: I give my permission for my child's name and/or photo to be used in relation to this summer camp or event in media such as The Beltonian Theatre website, The Beltonian Theatre social media pages, newspaper/radio/television/magazine stories, etc.
